- 10:00am **National Museum of Health and Medicine**
See the development of medical technology while visiting the largest museum in the world dedicated to health and medical technology. The National Museum of Health and Medicine has biological and chemical specimens of diseases, body parts and prosthetics for soldiers and citizens alike.
- 11:30am Board your motor coach.
- 12:00pm **Smithsonian Museums**
Explore the world's largest museum complex and research organization, the Smithsonian Institution. There are sixteen museums in Washington, DC, including National Air and Space, National Museum of Natural History, the National Art Gallery, Freer Gallery of Art, the Hirshorn Museum of Contemporary Art and National Museum of the American Indian.
- 1:00pm Own arrangements for lunch at one of the Smithsonian cafeterias.

- 5:00pm Own arrangements for dinner at Union Station.

Union Station, the gateway to the capital city is considered one of the finest examples of Beaux-Arts architecture. There is the opportunity to explore the shops and boutiques.

- 6:30pm **Illuminated Driving Tour of Washington's Monuments**
Board your motor coach for an illuminated driving tour of Washington's famous monuments and memorials, conducted by your Tour Leader. Stops include at the Lincoln Monument, Korean Memorial, Jefferson Memorial, the FDR Memorial, World War II Memorial, and Iwo Jima.

- 7:00pm **Baltimore Orioles Baseball**
