

## Day One

Regarded for centuries as one of the most majestic natural features in the region, Canyon Sainte-Anne offers groups the opportunity to cross suspension bridges over a spectacular 74 metre waterfall at the base of the canyon. There are also well-maintained nature trails available for hiking.

The group has the opportunity to make its own arrangements for lunch.
- 2:15pm **Montmorency Falls**  
Stop at the 83 metres tall Montmorency Falls, one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the Beupre Coast. Make sure to take a breathtaking picture from the middle of the bridge spanning the top of the falls!
- 3:30pm **Old Quebec Exploration**  
Explore Old Quebec and experience life in the days of New France.
- 5:00pm Board your motor coach and return to your accommodation to relax and freshen up.
