- 8:30am Board your motor coach
- 9:30am **Untouchables Gangster Tour of Chicago**
During your Untouchables Gangster Tour, a local gangster hijacks your motor coach for a two-hour tour through Prohibition Era Chicago. See the hot spots, hit spots, and hideouts made famous by Al Capone, his allies, and enemies.
- 11:30am Own arrangements for lunch along Michigan Avenue.

Explore Michigan Ave, otherwise know as the Magnificent Mile. Over 460 stores, 275 restaurants, 51 hotels, and two unique museums make-up Chicago's "main street". Don't miss the Wrigley Building, Tribune Tower or the Water Tower.

Visit the John G. Shedd Aquarium, one of the oldest public aquariums in the world. NOTE: The Oceanarium presentation is not available in 2009 due to the renovation.

Catch the 2005 World Series Champion Chicago White Sox at US Cellular Field (ticket availability subject to schedule).

- 10:00am **Museum of Science and Industry**
The Museum of Science and Industry is the oldest science museum of its kind in the Western Hemisphere, and features over 2,000 interactive units including a WWII captured German submarine, a 3,000-square-foot model railroad, and the Apollo 8 Spacecraft.
- 12:00pm **Loop Orientation Walking Tour**
Your Tour Leader conducts an orientation walking tour of the Chicago Loop. Home of the modern skyscraper, this district is still Chicago's financial and commercial hub.
- 1:00pm Own arrangements for lunch in the Loop.
- 2:30pm **Art Institute of Chicago**
One of the great art museums of the world, the Art Institute of Chicago's collection spans 5,000 years of artistic expression through paintings, prints, drawings, sculptures, photographs, video, and textiles.
