

Day One - Wednesday May 27, 2009

- 11:00am **Welland Canal Visit - Tour Canal, Locks, Video & Museum**
Arrive in Welland at the St. Catharines Museum and Lock #3 Viewing Complex. Learn how ships travel from Lake Erie to Lake Ontario without going over Niagara Falls! Check out the museum that chronicles the industrial, cultural, and social history of the area, and experience the rich legacy of Niagara's African Canadians and the role that St. Catharines played in the Underground Railroad.
- 12:00pm Time to enjoy your packed lunch from home on the grounds of Queenston Heights.
- 1:00pm **Guided tour of Queenston Heights & Brock's Monument**
Students do a walking tour of Queenston Heights Battlefield. This strategic point in the War of 1812 was where General Brock's troops defeated the Americans, thus ensuring our Canadian heritage. General Brock and his aide-de-camp, Lieutenant Colonel Macdonell, lost their lives during this battle and are buried underneath Brock's Monument.
- 2:30pm **Niagara Parkway Driving Tour**
Your Tour Leader will conduct a driving tour along the beautiful Niagara Parkway.
- 4:30pm **Niagara College Residence (Glendale) - Hotel Check In**
Check into your hotel. Opportunity to unpack and freshen up.
